




# **HUMAN CAPITAL POTENTIAL – Availability - METROPOLIS**

#### The goals of Metropolis GZM:


- social and economic development

**High population density** - (879 people/sq. km), significantly higher than the average for Poland (123 people/sq. km). **A high rate of employment activity** –310 working people per 1,000 inhabitants of GZM, while the figure for the entire country is 255 people.


ACCUMULATED JOB

NUMBER OF JOBS CREATED SINCE Q1 2016





#### CATALYSING INVESTMENT THROUGH PARTNERING HUB



## **PUBLIC AID - KATOWICE SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE**


